All food and lodging will be supplied through Nyack College beginning with dinner on Monday, June 11<sup>th</sup> D.V. and ending with breakfast on Saturday, June 16<sup>th</sup>. On Monday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, registration will be available starting at 1:00 pm at Simpson Hall with the opening prayer service commencing at 7:30 pm in the Olson Auditorium of Pardington Hall. Synod 2012 is scheduled to be completed late on Friday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Because of the distance from Nyack to the airport and airline requirements for arrival in time to clear security and immigration, final facility checkout is not until 11:00 am on Saturday, June 16<sup>th</sup>. Please schedule return flights with this in mind.

## **Accommodations**

The college provides mostly air-conditioned dormitory-type lodging (doubles, triples, quads and some singles) in both Christie Hall and Simpson Hall. It also has limited apartments at Dunbar.

The campus is hilly and most of the facilities have only stairs to gain access (no ramps). If you require a wheelchair or suffer more than a mild cardiac or respiratory compromise, it is *not* recommended that you attend this synod.

## **Amenities**

Overlooking the Hudson valley, all meals are served buffet style with hot and cold options for breakfast and, for both lunch and dinner, an entrée, vegetable, pasta plus a variety of desserts and beverages – all in unlimited portions.
